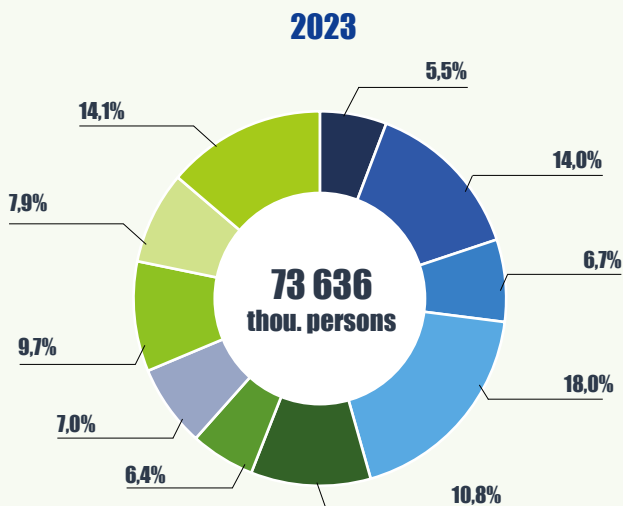

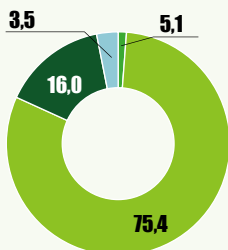
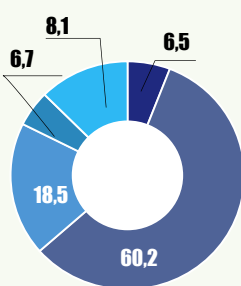
**MONETARY INCOME AND EXPENSES OF THE POPULATION**
