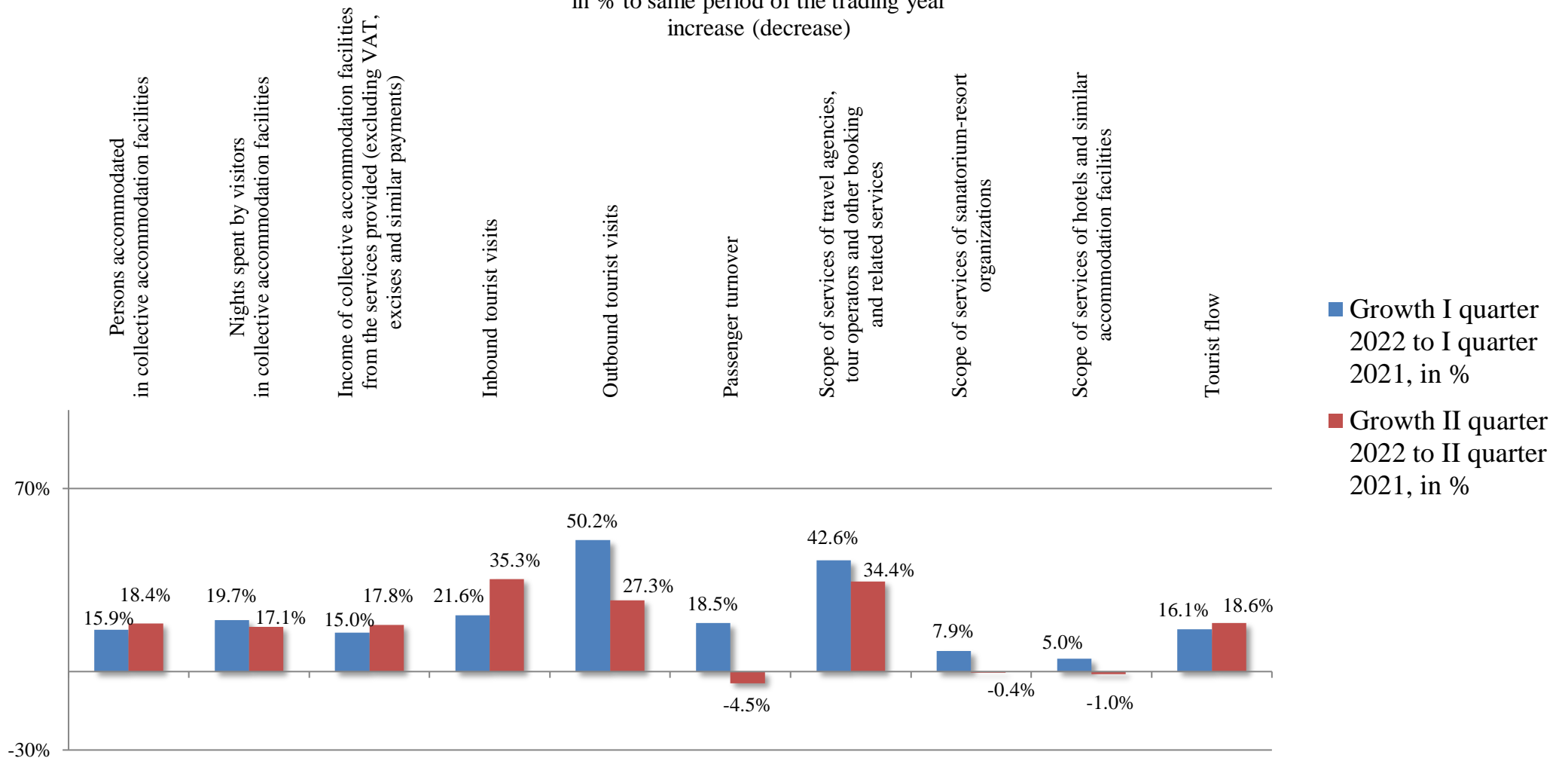

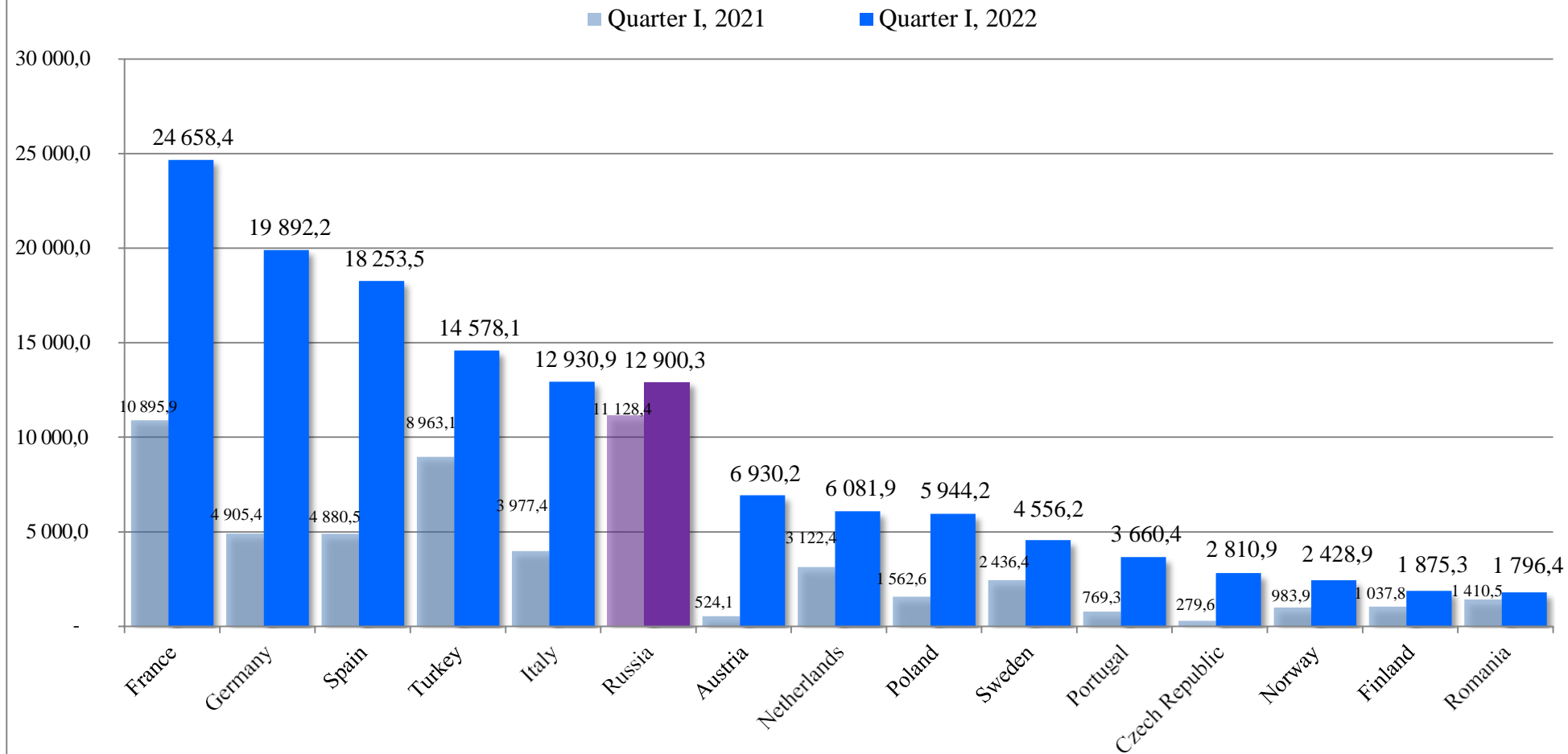

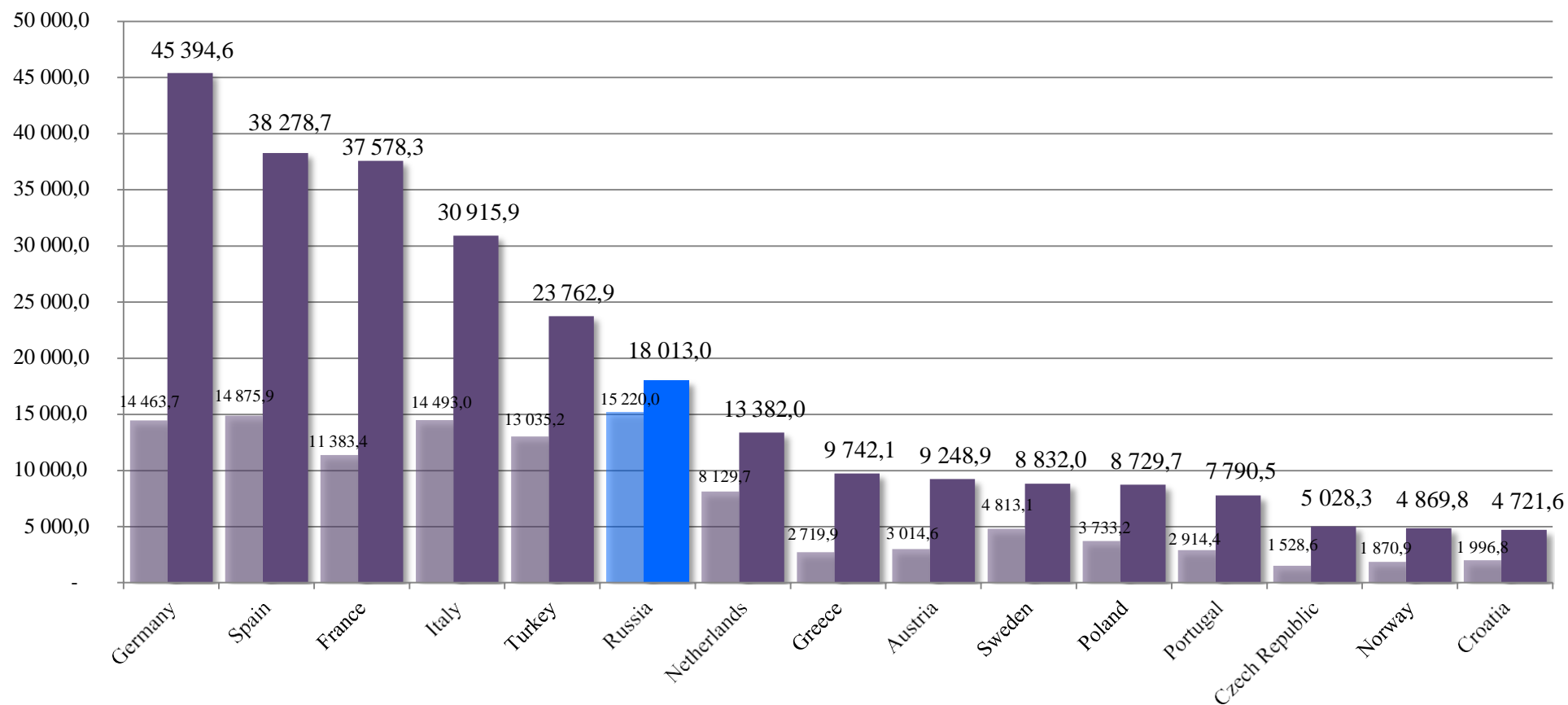
## Persons accommodated in collective accommodation facilities in Russia and European countries in 2021-2022





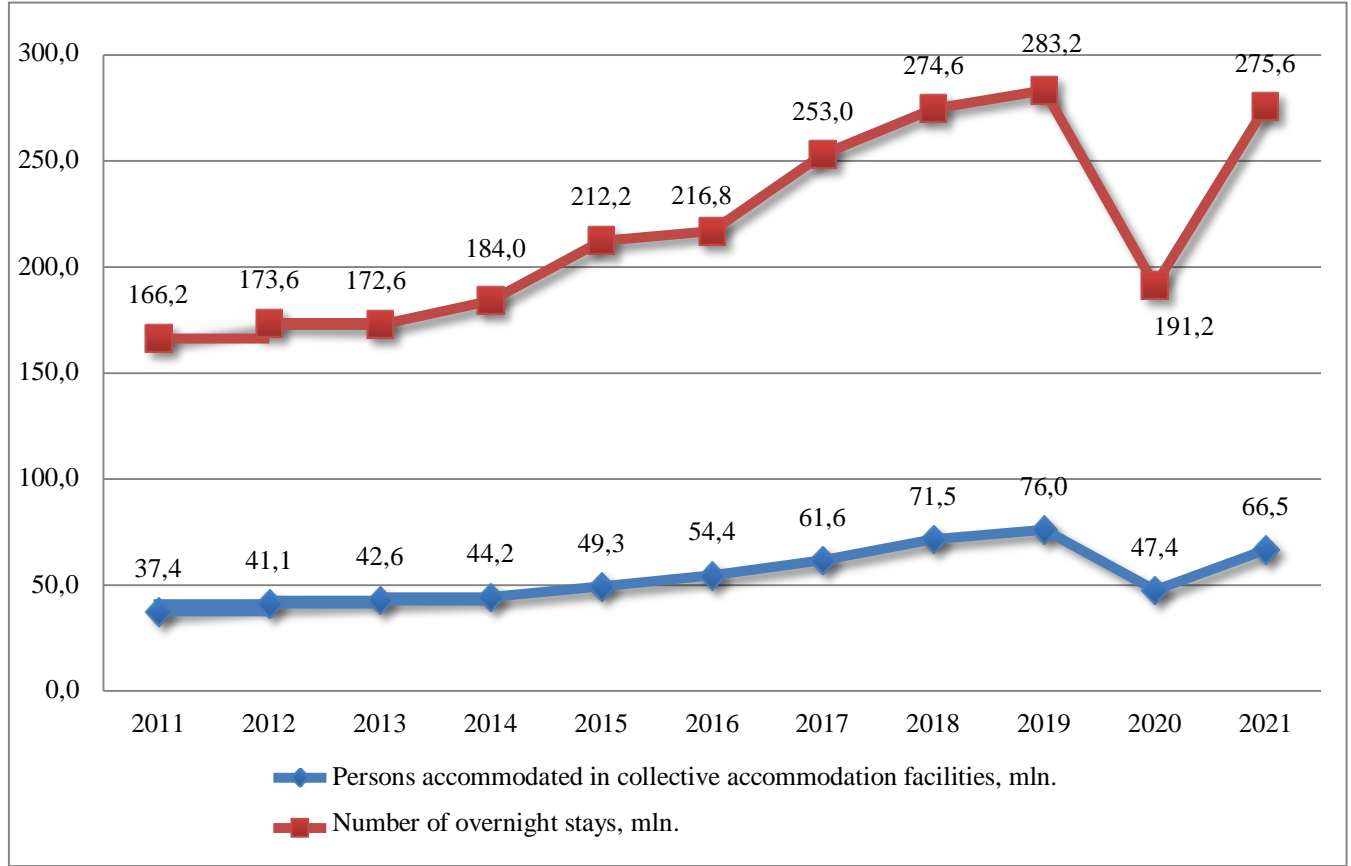

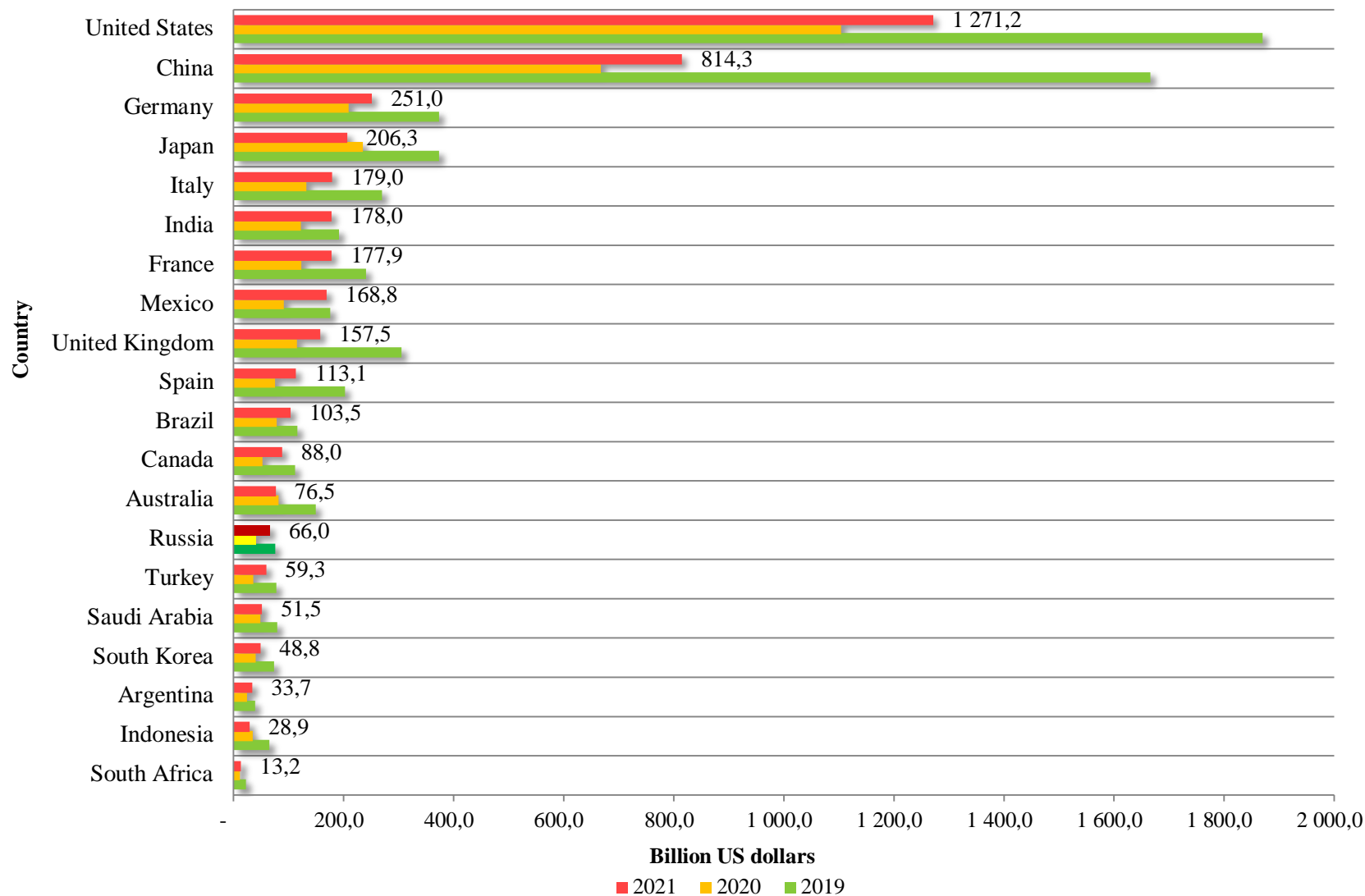

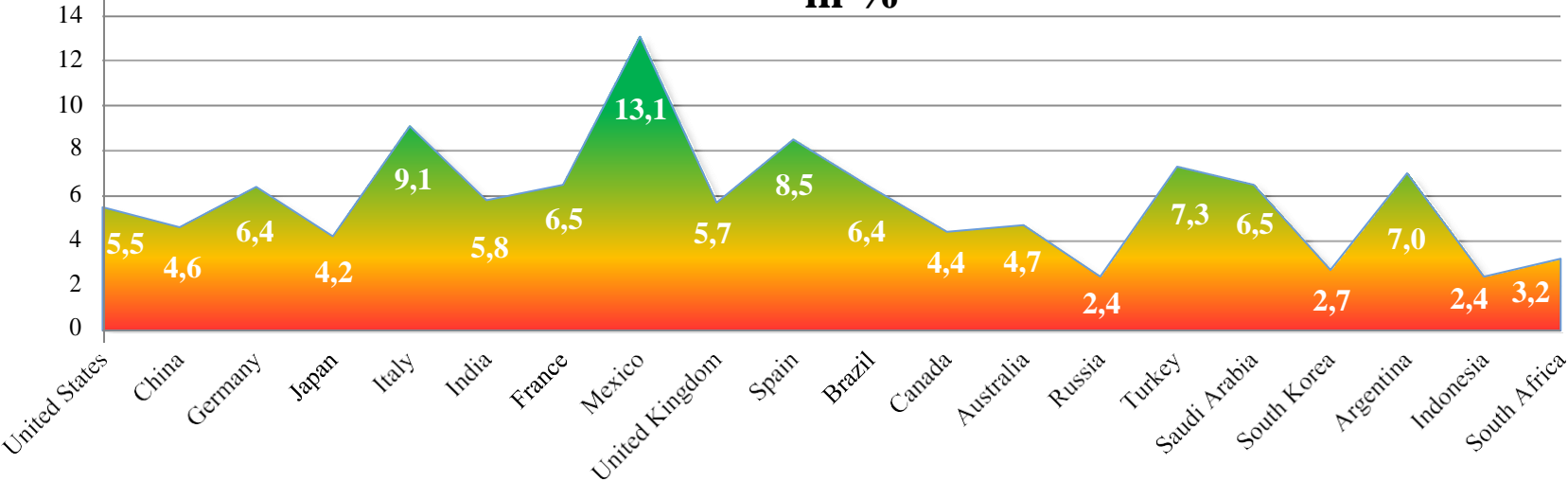
